



Public Parking Lot Policy

Policy Statement

The East Moline Public Library provides a public parking lot that is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The primary purpose of the parking lot is to provide accessible parking for patrons of the library but is available to all community members on a first-come first-served basis.

Abandoned Vehicles

Vehicles parked for longer than 48 hours will be considered abandoned and towed at the owner's expense.

Vendors and Non-Library Events

Vendors may not park and sell goods in the Library Parking Lot unless in conjunction with a Library or City event. The Parking Lot is not available for private use or events, even on days when the library is closed. Events where the City of East Moline is a sponsor or partner may request use of the parking lot by contacting the Library Director.

Electronic Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

The EV Charging parking spots are leased by MetroLink and all equipment is property of MetroLink. MetroLink is responsible for maintaining all equipment and ensuring equipment is functioning correctly. Fees for charging are collected by MetroLink and are not reimbursed to the Library. Questions, concerns, or complaints regarding EV equipment should be directed to MetroLink by calling the number listed on the EV Chargers.

The EV Charging parking spots must be available for use 24 hours a day. Only vehicles actively charging may be parked in EV Charging parking spots. Non electronic vehicles or vehicles not actively charging parked in an EV parking spot may have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense.
